

144 Avenue Concept Planning Study

About the Project

144 Avenue is a 4-lane divided collector roadway and bus route with intermittent on-street parking lanes, providing access to seven neighbourhoods: Evansdale, Kilkenny, McLeod, Casselman, Kildare, York, and Northmount.

The Concept Planning Study for 144 Avenue, between 50 Street and 97 Street, will support the design of a safe and welcoming street. It will consider traffic and pedestrian safety, access, parking, and accommodation for pedestrians, bikes, transit and cars. This study will inform design decisions for the future renewal plans of the corridor.

Study Area

The project covers 144 Avenue between 50 Street and 97 Street.

Project Timeline

The Concept Planning Study is anticipated for completion by the end of 2019. Construction of 144 Avenue, between 66 Street and 82 Street, is currently slated for 2022-2023. Construction timing for the remainder of the 144 Avenue corridor is not yet known.



Public Engagement

The project team has met with stakeholder groups in the community to kick off the development of the vision and values for 144 Avenue.

The June 19 public meeting will provide attendees the opportunity to provide feedback on a draft Vision Statement and values for the desired user experience along 144 Avenue. Feedback on the priorities for elements such as parking, landscape, crosswalks, curbs and more, will also be established at this meeting. This will help the project team to identify what options are available and what tradeoffs may need to be considered to accomplish the vision, while considering the upcoming renewal requirements.

Next Steps:

This project is in the early stages of planning. The design for 144 Avenue will be presented for public feedback at a future event.
