


Which neighbourhood do you live in? (88 responses)




How often do you visit the strip mall? (choose the closest answer) (88 responses)




Rate the appearance of the building. (88 responses)




Rate the appearance of the landscaping around the building (88 responses)




Which businesses have you visited and how often?



How can we enhance the strip mall experience for you and rate their importance?




How do you USUALLY access the strip mall? (88 responses)



If you were able to choose 2 new types of businesses for the strip mall, what would they be? (please choose 2)


