Due to the nature of the real estate market and physical change to properties, not all neighbourhoods or single-family homes reflect the city-wide median increase in assessed property values.

Every year, the City reviews market values for all properties within Edmonton, as required by provincial legislation. This market value review, or property assessment, is then used as a mechanism to determine the amount of municipal and provincial education taxes property owners pay in proportion to the value of the real estate they own.

On average, in 2018 property assessments have remained stable. The typical single-family home in Edmonton is now assessed at \$399,500, which represents a 0.6% increase when compared to 2017 values.

This report outlines the median assessment values for single-family homes (does not include condominiums, townhomes, duplexes, triplexes, fourplexes, manufactured homes and other types of residential properties) in each Edmonton neighbourhood, where the property count as of December 31, 2017, was greater than 50.
