Adult Fitness Skate (In Orange)	- Early morning public skating opportunities for adults ages 18+. Figure skating not permitted FREE Skate/Helmet rentals available for this program						
Figure Skate (In Magenta)	- Figure skating is intended for individuals to advance skill and technique through practice of figures and choreographed free skating; Figure skates required - All ages welcome; children under the age of 8 must be actively supervised by a responsible person aged 13 - Figure skate rentals are NOT available						
Older Adult Skate (In Purple)	- Public skating opportunities for older adults to skate and socialize - FREE Skate/Helmet rentals available for this program						
Parents and Tots & Sticks and Pucks (In Green)	One half of the rink is available for Parents and Tots skating while the other half is used for Sticks and Bucks						
Downtown Community League Skate (In Pink)	- Public skating opportunities for members of the 6 downtown community leagues and affiliated agencies - Must show proof of community league membership to access - Children under the age of 8 must be actively supervised by a responsible person aged 13+ - FREE Skate/Helmet rentals available for this program
