

DAY CAMPS IN THE RIVER VALLEY

Aspen Adventurers (Ages 6-12) \$260 (5 Days) \$210 (4 Days)

We invite your camper to play outside and unravel the natural mysteries of the River Valley! They can join us for a week of outdoor adventures as we go on nature treks to learn about the plants and animals that live around us, play games, cook some bannock, make crafts, and so much more. We'll even learn how to fish on the North Saskatchewan River!

Bike & Splash (Ages 8-12) \$300 (5 Days) \$240 (4 Days)

Bike & Splash is an energetic camp that teaches participants the basics of trail biking with a bike specialist. Participants will learn how to travel in different types of road safety situations, and explore the trails in the beautiful River Valley. Three afternoons will be spent at the Queen Elizabeth Pool, depending on weather. Bikes and helmets are provided.

Blazers (Ages 5-7)

\$315 (5 Days) \$255 (4 Days)

Your camper will enjoy blazing around camp while learning about nature, tree identification, learning about bugs and other animals in the area. Do some cloud watching, walk the trails, play fun games and silly songs. Your little blazers will also enjoy nature crafts, cooking bannock over a fire, story time and bird watching. Allow this classic camp to bring out the joy of being a child and the wonder of exploring the great outdoors

Challengers (Ages 9-11) \$275 (5 Days)

Let your child take on new challenges this summer as they mount a bicycle each day and tour the River Valley. They'll explore Edmonton ponds by tandem canoe, go longboarding on the trails and visit Victoria Park for archery and group challenges. Think they'll have the land skills covered? We'll throw in a half day of swimming to make sure your child is just as confident in the water. Bikes and helmets are provided.



Duskbusters (Ages 8-12)

\$275 (5 Days) \$225 (4 Days)

Be the ultimate camper! Figure out what it takes to camp out overnight under the stars. We'll practice outdoor cooking, fire making and shelter building. Camp-savvy leaders will provide tips and guidance throughout the week so you're ready for the Thursday night camp out. Keep in mind no camp out is complete without a campfire!

Explorers (Ages 8-12) \$270 (5 Days)

Does your camper need an outdoor adventure twist? Your child will go on a series of adventures throughout the River Valley from biking through the River Valley to exploring the North Saskatchewan by voyageur canoe. You camper will also get to reach new heights by trying out their climbing skills at Rock Jungle. Some other adventures you can look forward to include GPS, survival skills, and orienteering. Bikes and helmets are provided.

Jr Rangers (Ages 5-7) \$315 (5 Days) \$255 (4 Days)

Does your child have what it takes to be a River Valley Junior Ranger? At this camp, they'll develop camping and wilderness survival skills such as outdoor cooking, fire building, and shelter building, along with a wide array of games, crafts, and songs. We'll even learn how to fish on the North Saskatchewan River! We will complete the week with a visit from a genuine Edmonton Park Ranger.

Quest (Ages 13-15) \$360 (5 Days)

This is the most advanced of our camps and focuses on fostering leadership skills. Learn paddling techniques through tandem, voyageur canoeing and stand-up paddle boarding. Hone your no trace camping skills such as fire building, outdoor cooking, knot tying and shelter building. We will even set out on a voyageur canoe trip down the mighty North Saskatchewan River. Try out your new leadership skills by leading an activity that you've designed with younger participants from another camp!



Taste of Nature (Ages 6-12) \$125 (2 Days)

Kick off your summer with this 2 day action packed outdoor adventure camp. Explore everything nature has to offer from exploring the trails, to playing wide games and making some nature crafts. You'll even get the opportunity to cook some bannock over a fire.

Trackers (Ages 11-15) \$340 (5 Days) \$270 (4 Days)

Your camper can learn how to survive the great Canadian wild! Campers will spend the week developing skills such as fishing, archery, navigation, survival crafts and shelter building. On Thursday, we will put their skills to the test and camp under the stars in a River Valley park they can choose to use the shelter they built (camping tents will be available).
