# WIPE OUT GRAFFITI VANDALISM

- Maintain your property.
- Remove graffiti vandalism as soon as it occurs.
- Enhance security around your property.
  - Keep area well lit.
  - Keep open sightlines and maintain landscaping.
- Use anti-graffiti coatings.
- Create a mural.
  - Apply for the Community Mural Matching Grant.



# **RECORD**

 Photograph & record vandalized property for police and insurance purposes.

### **REPORT**

- Call 911 if you witness graffiti vandalism in progress.
- Report the crime online with the Edmonton Police Service or call the non-emergency complaint line at 780-423-4567 or #377 from a mobile phone. You can also file a report at your local police station if the graffiti vandalism occurs on your own property.
- Call 311 to report graffiti vandalism on property other than your own.

# **REMOVE**

  - Professional Graffiti Cleaning Program.
  - FREE Graffiti Clean-up Kit.

### **COMMUNITY STANDARDS BYLAW 14600**

 Requires property owners to promptly remove graffiti vandalism from their property within a reasonable timeframe (fine is \$250).
