ROGERS PLACE ARENA TRAFFIC UPDATE - JANUARY 2, 2015

Overnight Road Closures, 104 Avenue, 101 St - 103 St

Starting January 6, 2015, 104 Avenue between 101 and 103 Street will be closed to all traffic overnight, from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Monday to Friday. Please use 102 Avenue or 107 Avenue instead. The road will be open for peak hour traffic.

Overnight road closures will continue for about six months, ending late June/early July. There may be one month where closures are not needed, which is currently scheduled to be from mid-March to mid-April. Roadway signs will be updated to communicate when overnight closures will resume.

The closures are necessary to allow for the safe installation of the Winter Garden pedway over 104 Avenue, with minimal disruption to traffic.

Traffic movements

Traffic at 104 Street and 104 Avenue will remain unchanged, with eastbound traffic allowed to turn south and north at 104 Street. Signs will be put up encouraging eastbound traffic to divert at 105 Street. Westbound traffic will be diverted at 101 Street.

There may also be occasional lane closures along 104 Avenue to accommodate further utility work.

Noise Bylaw Relaxation

PCL Construction received permission from the City of Edmonton to work overnight through a relaxation of the City's Noise Bylaw. This allows crews to work beyond the standard time regulations in the bylaw (7 a.m. to 10 p.m., Monday to Saturday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Sunday) for the time it takes to build the steel structure over 104 Avenue.
