

Past Public Involvement

- Planning study of Buena Vista Road was completed at the end of 2014.
- Public information sessions were held on:
 - May 22, 2013 (Laurier Heights NBHD Renewal)
 - June 10, 2014 (Gathering Feedback)
 - September 23, 2014 (Concept Plan Presentation)
- The plan developed from this study is what is being implemented for construction.



Results of Concept Plan

- Maintain four lanes of traffic.
- Introduce a boulevard between the sidewalk and the road.
- Maintain parking.
- Maintain a centre median.
- Introduce raised crosswalks and curb extensions.
- Traffic circle to be implemented at the Laurier Heights Park / Zoo entrance.

Road Construction


- Construction on Buena Vista Road will be staged over 2 years, and it's scheduled to start May 2015
- Contract has been awarded to the lowest qualified bidder
- Two-year contractor warranty period

Construction Staging


 Construction will be staged over two years (2015-2016)



 Ultimate staging is dependent on weather conditions, coordination with utilities, and unforeseen design and construction issues







DECORATIVE STREET LIGHTS UPGRADE

- Expression of Interest: Completed
- Via: Local Improvement Tax
- Local Improvement process included in the MGA Regulations

BRINGING OUR CITY VISION TO LIFE

Decorative Street Light Project Supported

- < 50% petitions received back
- Property owners therefore pay the incremental difference for the street light upgrade to:

Black Heritage Arm decorative street light with Fluted Poles



Local Improvement Process

- City prepares Local Improvement Plan
- Notices sent to owners
- Bylaw prepared
- 30-day petition period
- Bylaw is scheduled for 3 Readings to City Council
- Construction
- Local Improvement Tax Levy
