West Sheffield Industrial - Road Rehabilitation **109 - 114 Avenue; Mayfield Rd. – 170 Street**

As part of the 2017 construction program, the City of Edmonton, Integrated Infrastructure Services will be involved in road construction in the West Sheffield Industrial Neighbourhood. **Please refer to the map on the back of this bulletin for the scope of work for the 2017 construction season.** The contractor will be delivering another bulletin prior to improvements being performed on your street with estimated start and end dates of construction.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in late May 2017, weather permitting. Construction is anticipated to be complete by middle of September 2017.

Scope of Work

The construction involves spot concrete repairs and base repairs, in addition to full rehabilitation of the roadway including a new asphalt pavement overlay.

During the final paving process, it may be necessary to pave over commercial crossing aprons in order to maintain drainage towards the roadway. The process of paving into the commercial crossing aprons will commence after the local roads have been paved.

Access

During the construction period, one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained whenever possible. Please follow the direction of flag persons when they are controlling traffic and abide by all construction signage. No parking will be permitted in signed areas. Access to businesses will be maintained where possible at all times. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

The roadway may be closed to traffic on selected days during off peak times to facilitate road reconstruction and asphalt paving. A bulletin will be circulated to the affected businesses 5 working days prior to any proposed full road closures.

Landscaping

As part of the construction process, some re-landscaping will be necessary.

Please mark all underground sprinkler systems to avoid damage during construction.
