Building Great Neighbourhoods

Building Great Neighbourhoods (BGN) is a long-term initiative that coordinates the efforts to renew, replace and enhance infrastructure in Edmonton neighbourhoods.

This includes:

- Reconstructing the pavement
- Replacing curbs and gutters
- Replacing sidewalks
- Adding sidewalks where there are missing links
- Adding curb ramps at corners of all intersections
- Replacement of streetlight bases and underground cabling
- Coordinating with other projects



Project Boundaries

- Newton neighbourhood boundaries extend from 118 Avenue to the Yellowhead Trail, and from 50 Street to 58 Street
- Newton north of 123 Ave, also known as Maypark, was developed later than the rest of Newton and is in better condition



- Drainage renewal work was completed throughout Newton
- The remainder of the neighbourhood renewal work is limited to south of 123 Avenue
- Additional projects beyond neighbourhood renewal include:
 - Park improvements at Germaine Dalton Park and Jacob Prins Park
 - Montrose-NewtonShared Use Pathproject
 - Corner Store
 improvements near
 Newton Centre
