105 Street, 82 Avenue to Saskatchewan Drive

As part of the 2015 construction program, the City of Edmonton Transportation Services will be involved in roadway construction in various neighbourhoods in Edmonton. Please refer to the map on the back of this bulletin for the work location. The contractor will be delivering a bulletin prior to improvements being performed on your street with estimated start and end dates of construction.

Weather permitting work is scheduled to begin at the beginning of May 2015 and be completed by the middle of July 2015.

Scope of Work

The construction involves miscellaneous surface milling and asphalt paving.

Access

During the construction period, traffic will be split to one side or directed by flag persons as required. No parking will be permitted in signed areas. Access to businesses, residences and alleys will be maintained where possible at all times. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

Please be advised that all ramping devices (rubber mats, concrete fill in gutters or otherwise) used to facilitate access into front driveways must be removed prior to construction. Any ramping devices left on the roadway at the time of rehabilitation will be removed by the contractor throughout the construction process. During the final paving process, it will be necessary to pave over driveway aprons in order to maintain drainage towards the roadway. The process of paving into the driveway aprons will commence after the local roads have been resurfaced. Please be advised that in cases where paving stones exist in driveway aprons, it will be the <u>owners</u> responsibility to remove and relay the stones after final paving. Paving stones in aprons that are not removed at the time of paving operations will be overlaid with asphalt as per the Neighbourhood Renewal Program.
