2018 Schedule

<u>The 2018 First Place implementation schedule</u> is now available online, and staff are gearing up for community consultations in Skyrattler, Dunluce and Michaels Park neighbourhoods. Dates are still being finalized and will depend on the availability of community residents and builder staff.

Depending on the outcome of the engagement sessions, the City will also be recruiting residents for the design engagement committees for Dunluce and Skyrattler, with the design engagement slated to begin in late 2018 and early 2019.

Construction of new homes are planned to start in <u>Twin Brooks</u> and <u>Belle Rive</u>, resulting in 42 and 88 townhomes respectively for the first time home buyers.

Program implementation plans will be flexible and adaptive to changing market conditions and available builder capacity. This may result in futures changes to the proposed implementation. Each fall proposed scheduling will be reviewed and any changes will be shared with relevant communities.

Bulyea Heights Design Engagement

Bulyea Heights design engagement started on December 8, 2016, and completed on April 27, 2017. The design engagement process involved representatives from the Community League, Homeowners Association, nine residents, and an adjacent business owner.

Twin Brooks First Place Program Design Engagement

Seven community residents, the City, and Landmark Homes participated in the design engagement process that resulted in the design of Twin Brooks First Place program with 42 townhomes.

The construction of the Twin Brooks First Place townhomes is expected to begin this summer, following the development permit approval.

Belle Rive First Place Program Design Engagement

Four community residents, the City and Rohit Communities participated in the design engagement process that resulted in 88 townhomes for the first time home buyers. The engagement process started in May and completed in August. Rohit Communities is preparing for the development permit submission. If approved, the construction is planned for 2018.

Construction and Sales Kernohan First Place

Construction of 62 homes in Kernohan is now complete. There are last few remaining units available for first time home buyers.

Larkspur First Place

<u>Construction and new home sales</u> for the 66 Larkspur First Place townhomes are underway. To date, 46 out of 66 homes have been sold. 39 families have already made Larkspur First Place their first home. Based on the construction of the remaining units, Rohit Communities are planning to complete the project by the end of 2018 or spring 2019.

Building construction and sales of 76 townhomes has started at Bulyea Heights Landing as the major site servicing work is wrapping up.

<u>Safety plan</u> is in place to manage the construction traffic along with the offsite foot traffic. Reclamation of the borrow pit area to the west of the current site will be completed by Summer 2018 depending on the the park development outline plan.

First Place Program Recap

City Council approved the First Place program in November 2006, allowing for the construction of homes for first-time buyers on 20 vacant school sites. The program addresses a recognized need for more entry-level housing in Edmonton, and continues to meet the needs of young families today.

The First Place program creates homes that are within reach of first-time buyers because the land cost is deferred for five years. Homes must be owner-occupied during that time period (i.e. no rentals). The townhome developments tend to attract recent post-secondary graduates and young professionals who grew up in or near to these new building sites.
