

SPEED OF PLAY

At Rundle Park Golf Course slow play detracts from players' enjoyment of the game. Remember that it only takes one slow group to back up all players behind. Be considerate of others and keep pace.

Hints to improve speed of play:

- Limit search for lost balls to two minutes.
- Play ready golf — proceed directly to your ball when safe to do so.
- If another player's line is not affected, continue until you hole out after taking first putt.
- Pick up your ball and proceed to next hole if your stroke count reaches double par.
- Allow the group following to play through if you have an open hole in front of you.
- Volunteer Player Assistants work on behalf of you and your fellow players. They are primarily responsible for ensuring that appropriate speed of play is maintained and course etiquette is observed.

LOCAL PLAY RULES

At Rundle Park Golf Course, Royal Canadian Golf Association rules govern play, along with the following:

- Ball may be dropped one club length from any staked tree well. No penalty.
- Ball lying on wrong green must be dropped one club length from green, no closer to hole. No penalty.

PLAY SAFE GOLF

- Respect the right-of-way of maintenance workers and equipment. DO NOT HIT onto a green if a flagstick is out.
- Recognize the authority of volunteer player assistants and golf course staff members as they enforce policies, procedures and etiquette.
- Individuals may be held responsible for injuries to other people and for damage to City or private property and equipment.
- An air horn indicates that play has been suspended for your safety.
- Appropriate attire, including shirts and shoes, must be worn at all times.
- Each player must have a set of clubs.
- Power carts must be driven responsibly and remain on designated pathways.
- The City is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.
- **Only alcohol purchased at the course is permitted.**
