

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO HOMEOWNERS, LANDOWNERS AND TENANTS WHO LIVE ALONG THE GREENBELT

The City of Edmonton will be installing precautionary fencing and signage around the Greenbelt area preventing entry.

Dear Homeowners, Landowners and Tenants,

The City of Edmonton was recently issued an Environmental Public Health Order by Alberta Health Services relating to a Greenbelt area (a narrow parcel of land north of Yellowhead Trail and west of Victoria Trail as shown on the attached map). A copy of the Order can be found at the Alberta Health Services website link provided below.

The Order directed the City to enclose the Greenbelt with precautionary fencing and signage by April 15, 2018 that will prevent entry into the Greenbelt until further notice. The fence will surround the entire Greenbelt with the north portion of the fence abutting directly to the property/fence line of current properties. Please immediately remove any encroachments or property located on the Greenbelt. Any encroachments or property remaining on the Greenbelt at the time the fence is installed will be removed and possibly destroyed.

This Greenbelt, now owned by the City, is in proximity to land previously operated by Domtar - an industrial company with a long history of using various wood-preserving chemicals from the 1920's to the 1980's.

The Province has directed other parties to conduct additional testing on the Greenbelt and other parcels that are adjacent to the Greenbelt. The safety of residents is of utmost importance, and the City is monitoring the situation closely in collaboration with Alberta Health Services and Alberta Environment and Parks.
