Work Limitations

Due to hazards involved, homeowners who are not certified master electricians may not do the following work:

- Install or relocate the main electrical service panel or service equipment
- Install swimming pool grounding or connect the electrical equipment for a permanently installed swimming pool
- Install a solar photo-voltaic (PV) system
- Electrical work if the house will be used for rental purposes

Responsibility of the Homeowner – Neither the granting of a permit, nor the approval of plans and specifications, nor inspections by a Safety Codes Officer shall in any way relieve the homeowner from full responsibility for carrying out the work in strict accordance with the Safety Codes Act and, the current adopted Canadian Electrical Code Part I.

I hereby certify that this installation will be completed in accordance with the Alberta Safety Codes Act & Regulations and work shall commence within 90 days. This permit expires after one year without an extension request.

I hereby declare that I am the owner of the single detached house and/or accessory structures in which the work will be conducted and that I reside in the house. I am performing the electrical work myself, and assume responsibility for compliance with all applicable Acts, Codes, Regulations, and Safety Code Permit Bylaw 15894.
