

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

170th Street Pedestrian Bridge: Tree Removal

Greetings,

The City of Edmonton will be undergoing work in your area which involves the 170th Street Pedestrian Bridge, located along 170th Street northwest between 90 Ave NW and 87th Ave NW. We would like to inform you that the retaining wall pre-construction activities are scheduled to begin in mid to late June with the removal of some trees and vegetation in the project site. Tree removal will not affect the flow of traffic, and the temporary pathway has been closed for the public's safety during this phase of construction. Tree Removals

Tree removals will begin mid to late June 2022. Tree removals are necessary to facilitate construction access required to complete the scope of work. Removals are being done in compliance with the City of Edmonton <u>Corporate Tree Management Policy</u>.

We are working with the City of Edmonton Forestry department to ensure a restoration and tree planting plan will be developed and implemented once the bridge is complete.

Project Update

The project is currently in its main construction phase and is anticipated to be complete in fall 2022.
