ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK EXPANSION: SHARED PATHWAY CONSTRUCTION

As part of the Active Transportation Network Expansion project, construction will begin on a shared pathway on the north side of 23 Avenue between 50 Street and 85 Street and 111 Street and 119 Street starting the **second week of August 2024**. This shared pathway will replace the existing sidewalk. Please see the back page for maps of the project area. This project is expected to be completed in the fall of 2024 with minor deficiency work to be completed in the spring of 2025.

The active transportation network is a connection of shared pathways and bike lanes that offer people more options for moving around the city, whether cycling, walking or rolling.

Construction details

The scope of work includes tree protection work, removal of the existing concrete sidewalk, excavation, gravel placement, asphalt work, street lighting relocation and site restoration work.

Access

There may be traffic disruptions and motorists are advised to follow traffic control signs for safe navigation through the construction zone(s). Some ETS bus stops within the project area will be temporarily relocated to ensure passenger safety, please follow posted signs to access the temporary bus stops. Pedestrian/cyclist detours will be in place for safe navigation through the construction zones, please follow the detour signs.

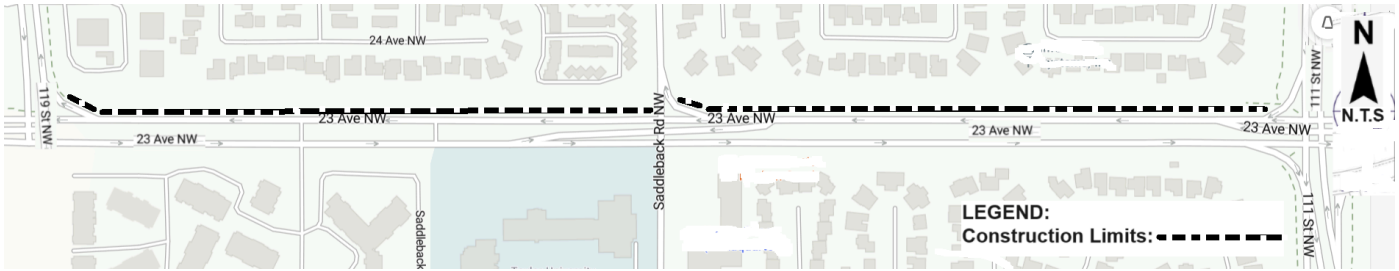

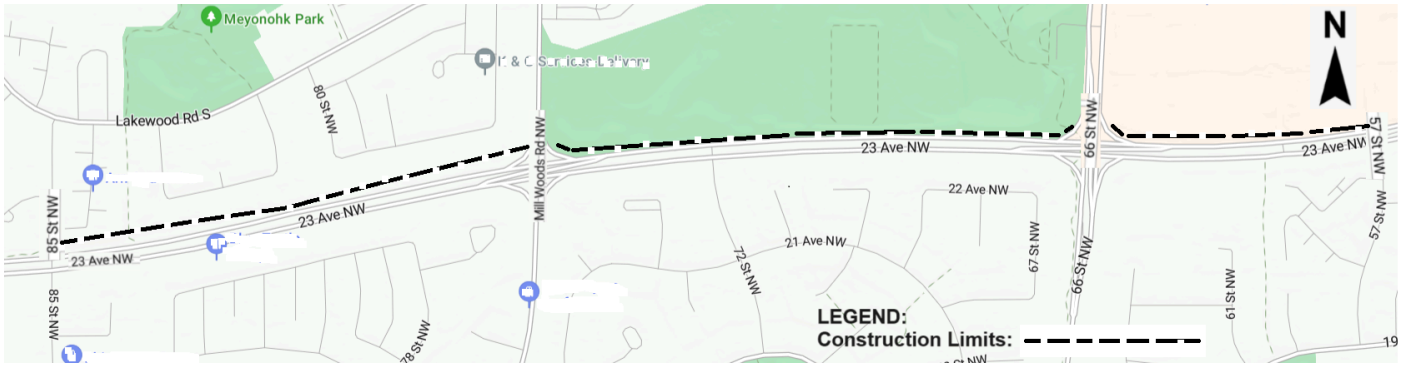
