



Safety improvements are coming to 40 Street and Hermitage Road!

The **Towards 40 program** is focused on improving road safety in areas where speeding and safety issues have been identified. It encourages safe driving habits and increases speed limit compliance.

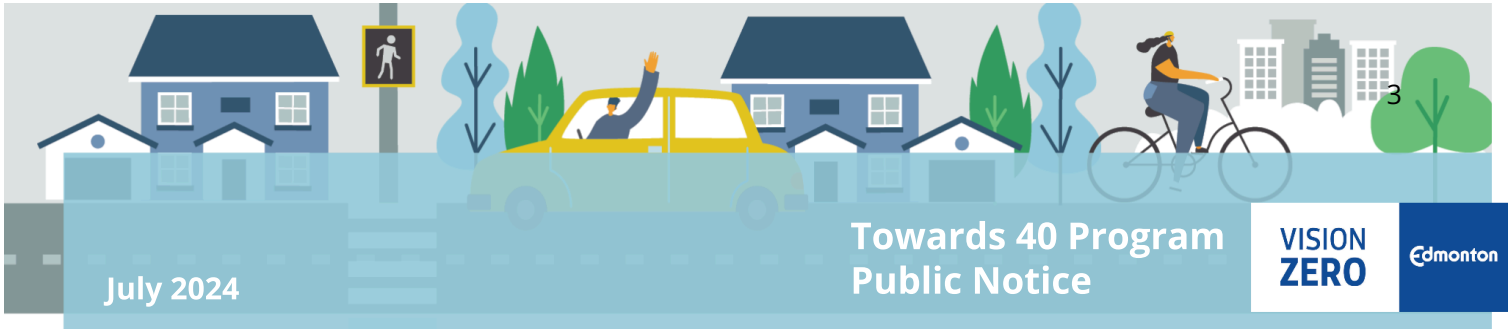
The City will be installing adaptable measures to improve safety on 40 Street and Hermitage Road, based on the data collected and the feedback heard from residents during public engagement.

The installation of the adaptable measures which include adaptable curb extensions and centre medians, pavement markings, signs and slip ramps— are expected to begin as early as the week of **July 8, 2024** and continue throughout the summer, weather dependent.

While the roadway will be accessible during installations, please anticipate some impacts, such as restrictions to some on-street parking, noise due to construction in the area and some temporary delays when there are work crews on site. Please follow any signage or site instructions, such as no-parking signage and directions from work crews in the area.

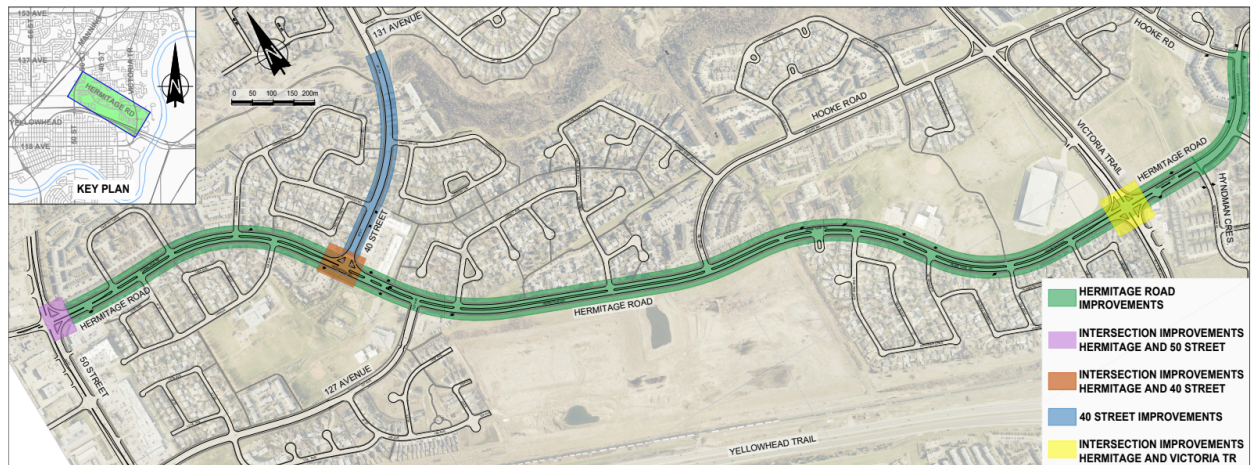

- **40 Street (between Hermitage Road and south of 131 Avenue)** is highlighted in **blue**.
- **Hermitage Road (between 50 Street and west of Hermitage Park Road)** is highlighted in **green**.
- The **intersection at Hermitage Road and 40 Street** is highlighted in **orange**.
- The **intersection at Hermitage Road and 50 Street** is highlighted in **purple**.
- The **intersection at Hermitage Road and Victoria Trail** is highlighted in **yellow**.



What's next?

After the installation, there will be a period for residents to get used to the changes while the City collects traffic data.

Edmontonians will have an opportunity to provide feedback on the adaptable measures and their level of comfort travelling in the project areas in spring/summer 2025. **A notice will be sent out during the evaluation phase with further information on how to provide feedback.**
