50 Street Widening and CP Railway Grade Separation

Construction on the 50 Street Widening and CP Railway Grade Separation project is underway. Upcoming work includes construction on the northbound bridge. The existing Morris Road intersection will be temporarily moved 100 meters north, near the CP Railway crossing. A detour will be put in place for motorists while this work is underway. **Construction on this phase of the project is anticipated to begin in November 2022.**

Timelines

- Construction on the northbound overpass is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2024. Construction on the southbound overpass is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2025. After completion, there will be three lanes of traffic on the northbound bridge and three lanes of traffic on the southbound bridge.
- The 50 Street Widening and CP Railway Grade Separation project is expected to be fully operational in 2026.

Access

During the construction period, detours will be in place and two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction. Emergency access will be maintained. Motorists will be asked to detour east of 50 Street from Sherwood Park Freeway to 80 Avenue/Morris Road. The existing 50 Street/Morris Road intersection will be closed and shifted to the north near the CP Railway crossing. **Affected location(s) are marked on the back of this bulletin.**




Figure 1 - 50 Street northbound bridge construction closure
