<p><b>4.1 Community Safety and Well-Being motion update and info</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- May 16, 2022 Community and Public Services Committee Meeting               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Back in Summer 2020, there were a series of public hearings which led to the creation of the Community Safety and Well-Being Task Force. The Task Force came up with 14 recommendations, which are intertwined into the Safer for All Strategy.</li> <li>- The Task Force, EPS and Administration developed a motion to</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		

<p>report back to Council.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- That Administration work in a collaborative, decision-making way with the Anti-racism Advisory Committee, additional BIPOC stakeholders and the Edmonton Police Commission, to provide additional clarity and actionable data points on the tangible outcomes taken with respect to the 14 recommendations, as outlined by the Community Safety and Well-Being Task Force (CSWB), in the next update on the "Safer for All Strategy".</li> <li>- Administration is asking three things from ARAC: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Any feedback on actions from an anti-racism perspective?</li> <li>- Have we missed any initiatives/actions that could be articulated?</li> <li>- Are there other initiatives that ARAC members are aware of that they would like us to highlight for the report?</li> </ul> </li> <li>- There are four reports going to the Community and Public Services Committee on May 16, 2022. The reports that will address the 14 recommendations from the CSWB Task Force include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Safer for All Strategy - Community Safety, Well Being, Inclusion and Anti-racism</li> <li>- ConnectEdmonton Next Steps</li> <li>- Community Safety and Well-being - Methodology and Results</li> <li>- Community Safety and Well-Being Action Plan</li> </ul> </li> <li>- There has been engagement with various community organizations.</li> <li>- On April 6, 2021 - CSWB Task Force report presented to City Council. On June 30, 2021 - List of quickly actionable items from City of Edmonton Administration and Edmonton Police Commission presented to the Community and Public Services Committee. Additional work completed since that time. There is a consolidated list with approximately 70 actions/outcomes.</li> <li>- Administration will follow up with sending an update in writing to ARAC members to allow them to review the presentation in depth at a later time. Co-collaboration will be in the 2nd step of the process of the Anti-Racism Strategy.</li> </ul>
