Alley Renewal Update!

Crawford Plains, Daly Grove and Pollard Meadows have been chosen for Alley Renewal and design is currently underway with construction anticipated to begin between 2023 and 2025.

Alley renewal includes:

- + Removing all alley road infrastructure (to the dirt) then reconstructing alley roads with a new base and hard surface
- + Improving surface drainage where possible
- + Minor widening to improve turning movements where space allows
- + Pruning alley trees and shrubs
- + Minor enhancements to improve connections for those who walk, bike or roll, where possible
- + Protective posts where needed to clearly identify where alleys end

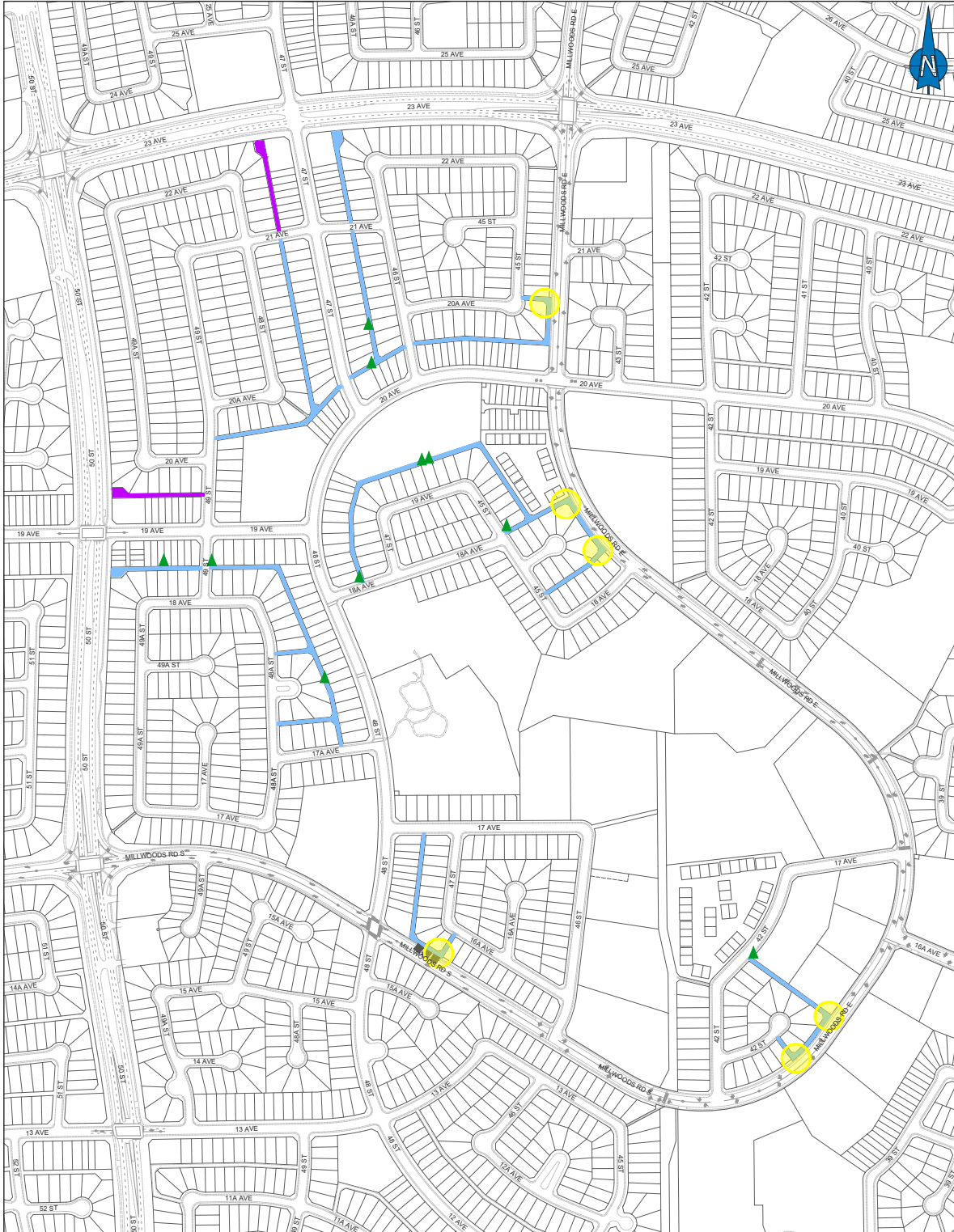

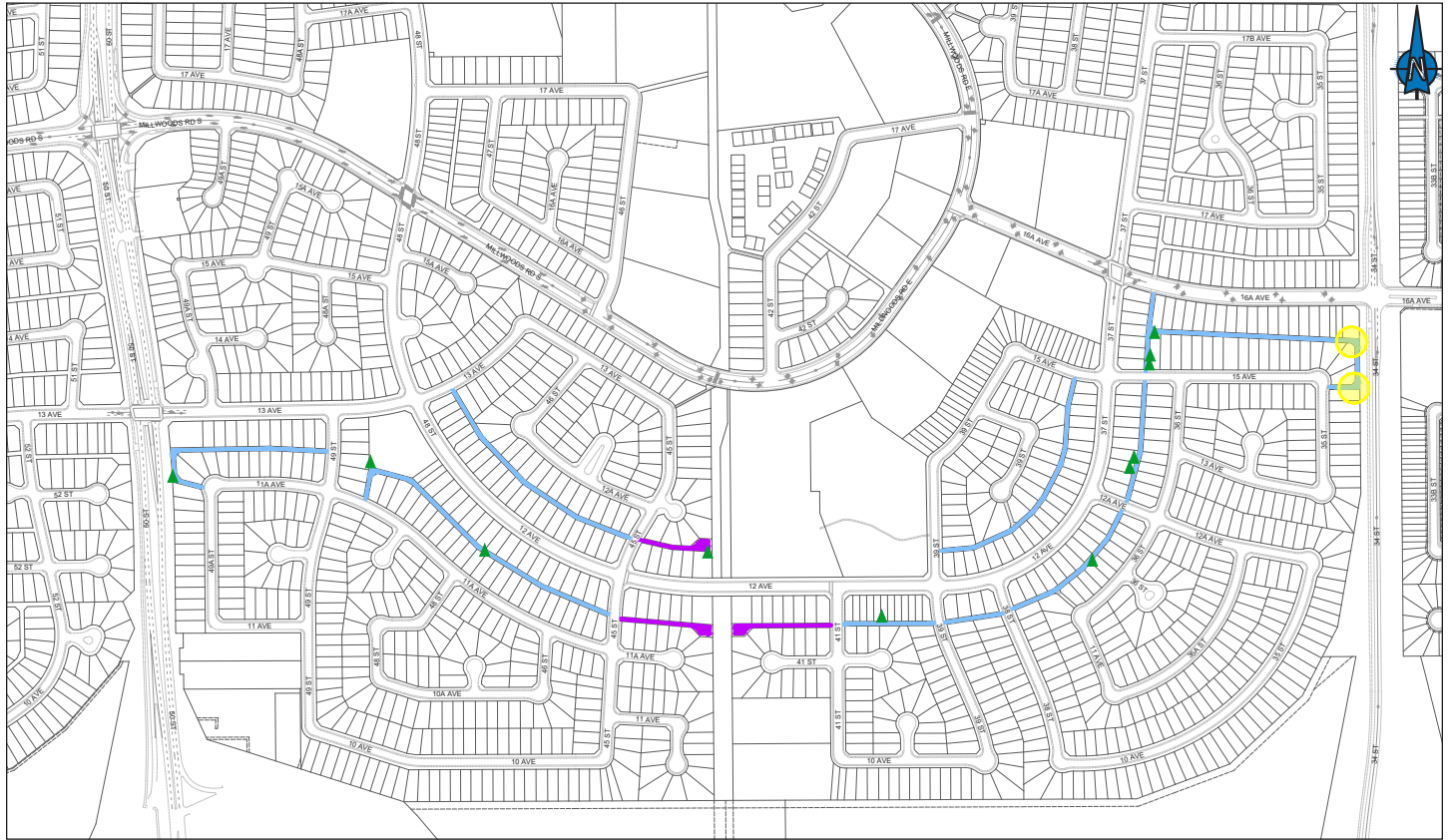

- + Turning movement improvements include minor widening of the driving surface. All neighbourhood alleys and access points were considered for widening but space constrictions limited this improvement.
- + Trees located on road right-of-way, (City property) have been identified as having possible impacts. The Forestry department will be conducting further assessments to understand these impacts.
- + Proposed wooden posts have been recommended in areas to better identify the alley driving space.

Construction

Construction of alleys in Crawford Plains, Daly Grove and Pollard Meadows is anticipated to occur between 2023 and 2025. Project updates including alley renewal staging will be available as we get closer to construction.

Once construction starts in your alley, it will not be accessible for about four weeks. During this time, parking and waste collection will move to the front street.
