Community Events

- + Residents were invited to attend community workshops hosted by the City of Edmonton on November 29, 2022, and December 5, 2022, at St. Maria Goretti School.
- + Participants were asked to share what they love about their community and what areas could be improved, such as adding missing sidewalk connections, creating new shared pathways and improving traffic safety along roadways.
- + Participants worked with Project Team members using stickers and drawing on maps of the neighbourhood to use local knowledge to identify specific locations for improvements.
