Online Survey

- An online survey was available to the public from April 15 30, 2022 asking participants to share how well the design reflected the Vision and Guiding Principles and if there was anything new that the project team should be aware of that might impact the final design.
- + Paper copies of the survey and design package were available to community members upon request.

40 people provided input through the survey 300+ comments were submitted through the survey



Community Conversations and Virtual Public Engagement Sessions

- 19 residents and/or stakeholder groups submitted questions through the online form or contacted the Project Manager directly to learn more about the project and share their perspectives on the design.
- 16 residents and/or stakeholder groups attended virtual public engagement sessions on April 21 and 23, 2022 to learn more about the project and ADVISE if there was any additional information that should be considered to best reflect the Vision and Guiding Principles for Baturyn in the final design.
- + 18 conversations with residents and/or stakeholder groups at meetings and community visits (including the Baturyn Playground Opening).
