Project Background

Capital Line South Extension (Phase 1) is a 4.5 kilometre, high-floor LRT extension along the west side of 111 Street from Century Park Station to the future Heritage Valley North Station north of Ellerslie Road. Capital Line Design-Build Ltd., a member of the Ledcor Group of Companies, with AECOM as their design partner, has been awarded the Design-Build contract for Phase 1.

Major construction began in 2025, and is anticipated to take 4–5 years to complete, followed by testing and commissioning.

Project Highlights

- High-floor LRT with crossing arms, gates and bells at intersections
- LRT underpass at 111 Street and 23 Avenue
- Two new bridges:
 - Blackmud Creek LRT bridge (west of existing traffic bridges)
 - Anthony Henday Drive LRT bridge
- Two new stations:
 - Twin Brooks Station (smaller-scale neighbourhood station)
 - Heritage Valley North Station (multi-modal station connecting to the Heritage Valley Transit Centre and Park & Ride)
- Llew Lawrence Operations and Maintenance Facility (where trains are maintained and stored; south of Anthony Henday Drive)
- Three utility complexes and one traction power substation
 - Supply power to the trains
- New Light Rail Vehicles (LRVs)
