Tree and shrub removals are starting at the Coliseum

In the coming days, City of Edmonton contracted arborists will begin removing trees and shrubs from the vacant City-owned Coliseum property (formerly known as the Northlands Coliseum), located at 7424 118 Avenue NW.

Trees and shrubs will be removed to prepare the property for future demolition work associated with the Coliseum Demolition Project. The City consults multiple sources, including the City of Edmonton Urban Forestry section, when determining whether the project can preserve trees and shrubs on a project site.

The City does not take tree and shrub removal decisions lightly. Removals are considered a last resort after all other options have been explored. Due to the extent of the demolition work, it was determined that the trees and shrubs on the Coliseum property must be removed.

The tree and shrub removals will be completed by an International Society of Arboriculture certified arborist under the direction of a City of Edmonton urban forester.

During the work, nearby residents may experience increased noise levels and traffic due to the nature of the work. The removals will take place between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m., Monday to Friday, in accordance with Community Standards Bylaw 14600.
