

## Smith Crossing Pedestrian Bridge Replacement

The Smith Crossing Pedestrian Bridge, located along 23 Avenue, provides access to the MacTaggart and Larch Sanctuaries in Edmonton's river valley system. The existing bridge was built in the early 1900's and has reached the end of its service life.

The City of Edmonton is preparing to replace Smith Crossing Pedestrian Bridge, with **construction anticipated to begin in November 2022**. Tree clearing and pruning will start prior to construction. The new bridge is expected to open in fall 2023.
