CONTEST RULES

- 1. There is no charge or purchase required to enter the contest. The chances of winning are dependent on the number of eligible entries received.
- 2. Stories must include a positive and personal experience with Edmonton Transit Service staff and will be limited to up to 150 words. Any words in excess of the 150 word limit will not be presented for voting.
- 3. Stories collected must be first-hand accounts. .
- 4. All winners' stories will be collected and will be presented to City of Edmonton employees for voting. Voting will be on all eligible entries received, and will be based on individual subjective choice by City of Edmonton employees who choose to participate in the voting process. All stories will be anonymized for a fair voting process.
- 5. The contest is open to residents of the Edmonton metropolitan area who are 18 years of age or older.
- 6. Only one entry is allowed per person per platform, or per email. Any subsequent submissions will not be entered into the contest.
- 7. Any entrant found to be using multiple accounts to enter the contest will be ineligible for the draw.
- 8. Emailed submissions or direct messages on social media may be circulated internally to City of Edmonton employees, and externally on Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram.
- 9. The contest is not open to current Edmonton Transit Service or City of Edmonton employees involved with the administration of the contest.

All submitted stories will be collected via direct messages on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and through email at takeETS@edmonton.ca between Wednesday, March 8, 2023 at 12:01 a.m. until Saturday, March 18, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. MDT. City of Edmonton staff will have the opportunity to vote on their favourite story through internal weekly newsletters, with voting closing at noon on Monday, April 3, 2023.

- 13. Winners will be promptly notified by direct message on social media (where possible) or through email.
- 14. Each entrant is only eligible to receive one prize.
- 15.
