Edmonton-Strathcona County Footbridge

Construction activities on the Edmonton-Strathcona County Footbridge will begin on **June 1, 2023** and continue until fall 2025. The new footbridge is being constructed to cross the North Saskatchewan River, linking the City of Edmonton (167 Avenue) with Strathcona County (Township Road 540). A temporary access road and laydown will be established during bridge construction.

Construction Impacts

- The shared pathway parallel to the North Saskatchewan River will be temporarily closed near the Quarry Gold Course with no through access to 167 Avenue northeast. Trail users can still access the trail from 17 Street northeast until the marked dead-end for the duration of construction.
- The gravel trails along the river's east side with access from Township Road 540 will also be closed.
- Access to homes and businesses surrounding the bridge site will be maintained.

- Some activities may require overnight work.

Access

Local access will be maintained at all times. Large trucks and equipment will be detoured to 153 Avenue and 17 Street to mitigate traffic impacts along 167 Avenue.



The final design has retained most elements shown during preliminary design, however, the canopies on the lookout points are no longer included to keep the project within budget. The Edmonton-Strathcona County Footbridge is a collaborative infrastructure project between the City of Edmonton, Strathcona County and the River Valley Alliance.

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


Image 1.1 – Trail and Parking Lot Closure Map


