



Curb extensions



What is a curb extension?

A curb extension extends the curb to define the parking lane and provide additional space for people who cross at key locations either at the corners of a street or at a mid-block crossing.

Raised crosswalk



What is a raised crosswalk?

A raised crosswalk is a marked crosswalk at an intersection which is constructed higher than the roadway surface.

What is a raised median

A raised median is an island located along the centerline of a street.


What is a speed table?

Speed tables are a raised section of the road with ramps on both sides. They are very similar to raised crosswalks but are not placed at crossings.




