Building Great Neighbourhoods organized the following activities to work with Hillview community members to create a Vision and Guiding Principles and gather local knowledge for Neighbourhood and Alley Renewal.

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Surveys

- + An online survey was available from November 7–25, 2022 asking respondents to help us **CREATE** a Vision and Guiding Principles for Hillview's Neighbourhood and Alley Renewal. We also asked people to **REFINE** our understanding of their lived experience in Hillview by identifying opportunities to improve or enhance the neighbourhood.
- + A paper "mini-survey" was offered to students at Hillview School to share their experiences in Hillview and identify areas for improvement

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Workshops

 An in-person guided walking tour was held on November 19, 2022. Participants met outside Hillview School and walked through the neighbourhood from 1:00–3:00pm, stopping at key locations to share their input about issues and opportunities for Neighbourhood and Alley Renewal.
