Thank you for the correspondence from Andre Corbould, City Manager, requesting an amendment to Order in Council 359/2018 – Leduc County annexation order. I understand the City of Edmonton has identified an error in the legal land description that unintentionally provided special tax treatment for an area of land.

I appreciate your interest in resolving this issue, and have attached Ministerial Order No. MSD:010/22 to refer this matter to the Land and Property Rights Tribunal (LPRT) for its review. The LPRT will review the city's request, and may choose to hold a public hearing on this matter, before making a recommendation for my consideration. I will advise you when the review process is complete and I have determined next steps.
