Rundle Park Road Reconstruction

The City of Edmonton and Lafarge will begin road reconstruction activities on Rundle Park Road starting on or around the week of July 4, 2022. Reconstruction work will be completed in phases, with construction anticipated to be complete by Fall 2022. Access to Rundle Park Road will be maintained throughout construction with alternate access points provided. Please refer to the phasing plan on the back of this bulletin for more information on the project area.

Scope of Work

- All aspects of road removal and reconstruction
- Curb stop replacement
- Culvert replacement
- Improved street lighting and landscaping

Work will be completed in stages, with Phase 1 and Phase 2 occurring at the same time. Phase 3 work will follow Phase 1 completion. The hours of operation will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Saturday.

Access:

Street parking may be limited during construction hours. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times while the site is under construction. To ensure continued safety, please follow the construction signage and barricades when entering or exiting the site. If you have special access requirements, such as DATS, please advise the contact person below.
