- Christine shared reasons for some of the policy points noting that this process will be taken if the member has not communicated with the Chairs or Admin after a number of attempts of communicating with the member. Also agrees to tie and reference and offer the leave of absence
- Julianne shared her comments, this policy is meant to be in place to enforce when there is no communication from the member after reaching out, key is communication and not left wondering or waiting
- Angelika someone on WAVE in the past did not attend and there was no policy in place so this process is needed to help address absence from the Committee
- Angelika asked if we want to pass the policy as it is or defer it to April's meeting and incorporate feedback?
- Fumi work on the policy more and refine it, stepping down is not always a bad thing, finding ways to support each other, want to have open communication, not a penalty to have this policy, want to better internal culture of committee
