 - Muno: Discussion on the work is grounded in relationships which is important. Shocked to hear Canada did not immediately sign the UN rights for indigenous rights
 - Michele: Stories were important allowed for sense of empathy, use of encounters, not just a report
 - Julianne: There was lots of emotion in the first chapter and it is important to share the stories of what happened

- Kendra: In the report, I appreciated the hope and optimism that comes with the word "encounter". The idea that each interaction has the potential to be negative or positive. It provides space and room for change
- Joan: There were both positive and negative relationships, there is change at the individual level
- Christine: The report reveals that indigenous women's voices were ignored and the importance of listening to women's voices must be realized. The four rights referenced: right to culture, health, security and justice which highlights how indigenous women's voices can be heard
- Michele: There has been an institutional lack of will for change
- Julianne: Frustrating people so naive, what is it to have a right, referred to page 123 of the report which struck a chord
- Angelika: sShared her thoughts, pervasiveness of it, just learning about this, systemic racism, intentionally hidden
- Michele: 4 root causes of violence, failure to recognize women's rights and come up with their own solutions
- Joan: Elders group, issue of agencies, building relationships, changing landscapes, fear we won't see the change of institutional will
- Kourtney: Thanks everyone for sharing perspectives, Kristina and Kourtney recommend to read thru the MMIWG report and eventually get to calls of justice and align with work of WAVE, this is a good place to start with WAVE's ongoing work on reconciliation
