- Partnered with 22 indigenous youth who are working on reconciliation, creating a multimedia video project and art installation for the festival
- Army and Navy music, partnering with Vignettes and creating installations as well for the cabaret
- Holy Trinity Church is another venue being used for choir performances
- Skirts competition, partnering with storefronts to showcase design
