Construction Bulletin

156 Street to St. Albert Trail

April 5, 2022

Project Overview

As part of the Yellowhead Trail Freeway Conversion Program, construction started in 2021 between 156 Street and St. Albert Trail. The project includes the removal of direct accesses to and from Yellowhead Trail at 149 Street and 142 Street; construction of one-way service roads north and south of Yellowhead Trail; various utility relocations; and replacement of the Dovercourt noise wall. Construction is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2023.

Construction Update

Standard General Inc., and its subcontractors, will be working in the project area, for the purpose of:

- Retaining wall excavation & installation – Graham Construction & Engineering Inc.
- Site grading – Wilco Contractors
- Underground utilities – Mid-City Construction Management Inc.
- Road restoration – Standard General Inc.
- Streetlight installation – Highline Electrical

The scope of work will require the temporary closure of the existing westbound Yellowhead Trail off-ramp at 156 Street.

Expected Schedule

- **April 4, 2022, to October 31, 2022**

It is the intention of Standard General Inc. to perform the above work in the most expedient and efficient manner as possible while endeavoring to minimize any inconvenience to you. Work will take place Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. according to the City's Community Standards Bylaw.

Please note, all schedule information is subject to change.

Traffic Accommodation

To access 156 Street, traffic will be directed to detour using the westbound service road:

- from westbound Yellowhead Trail, west of 149 Street; or
- from 149 Street at 126 Avenue.

Westbound Yellowhead Trail will also be reduced to two lanes between 149 Street and the 156 Street on-ramp to accommodate the construction activities.

As part of a staged approach to implementing the road network changes planned for this project, the service road from 149 Street to 156 Street will be reduced to traffic in the westbound direction only. This **permanent change** is tentatively scheduled for **April 25, 2022**. Additional communications will be shared prior to this change.

Safety

To assist us with the performance of this work we ask your co-operation with the following:

- Please obey the construction signage and barricades.
- Please follow the direction of flag people.
