

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

- + Installing new and upgrading existing lighting along pathways to improve user comfort






TYPICAL WIDENED PATHWAY








MOVEMENT Crosswalk upgrades

The Draft Design includes:

- Adding curb extensions and narrowing the road, slowing traffic and enhance the feeling of safety for people who walk by improving sightlines and providing a shorter crossing distance
- + Adding new zebra marked crosswalks to enhance the feeling of safety for people who walk and roll (locations 4 and 5)
- Assessing locations for the addition of a marked crosswalk to enhance the feeling of safety for people who walk and roll (locations 7 and 8)





MOVEMENT School drop-off upgrades



The Draft Design includes:

- + Adding concrete school bus drop-off pads in the boulevard between existing trees
- + The addition of curb extensions to slow traffic, shorten crossing distances and improve sightlines to enhance the feeling of safety for people who walk and roll
- + Adding new zebra marked crosswalks to increase the visibility of people crossing the road and enhance the feeling of safety for people who walk and roll

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









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












