What is Neighbourhood Renewal?

The program:

- Renews and rebuilds roads, sidewalks and street lights in mature neighbourhoods
- Neighbourhood Renewal is delivered in coordination with other City departments and projects in the area
- + Through coordination we can also improve other elements including intersection safety, pedestrian and bike connections, and park and City-owned green spaces



What's included

Infrastructure upgrades:

- Regrading and paving of local and collector roads*
- Replacing sidewalks**
- Replacing street lights
- Construct new sidewalks, where missing

Other potential elements:

- Implementing connections that help people move (walk, bike, drive)
- Making improvements to Cityowned green spaces (trees, furniture, beautification)
- Mitigating neighbourhood traffic issues
- Upgrading to decorative street lights**

What's NOT included

Infrastructure upgrades:

- Arterial roads
- Alleys
- + Development/redevelopment on non City-owned land
- Maintenance issues (snow clearing / lawn mowing / waste services)
 - + Concerns will be forwarded to the appropriate city area

Design

A new neighbourhood design that includes geometry for roads and sidewalks, as well as specific design elements such as materials

Build

Construction of the new neighbourhood design

Operate

Full function of the new neighbourhood design






