## Community Workshops

On Tuesday, January 28, 2020, three identical **Community Workshops** were held at the Malmo Plains Community League Hall starting at 3:00, 5:00 and 7:00p.m.

At the workshops the project team presented design options, with the benefits and trade-offs, that are being considered for neighbourhood renewal. Options presented included enhancements for parks, traffic calming measures, bike facilities and sidewalk and crossing improvements.

Information was also shared with residents about the Local Improvement options available for decorative street lighting and sidewalk reconstruction.

Community members were asked to help **REFINE** the design options. Participants completed workbooks provided to share their feedback and level of support for each option.

## Park Enhancements Voting Jars

Participants voted on the park enhancement options they wanted to see in the three pocket parks in the community. Enhancements included new trees, boulder play features, game boards, plantings, seating areas, a community garden and a shade structure.

The feedback from these workshops will be used, along with technical requirements and City policies and programs, to develop a draft design for the renewal of Malmo Plains neighbourhood.
