Drop-in Workshop

On Saturday, September 28, 2019, two identical community **Drop-in Workshops** were held at the Malmo Plains Community League Hall from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

We shared the draft Vision and Guiding Principles and the analysis of the neighbourhood identifying the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and constraints in relation to neighbourhood renewal.

We asked residents to confirm the Vision and Guiding Principles, and refine the assessment of the neighbourhood.
