By submitting this form, you confirm that:

- You consent to personal information related to your building(s) participation in Edmonton's Building Energy Benchmarking Program being collected, used and stored internally by the City of Edmonton for the purposes of the design and evaluation of energy transition programs.

- Inclusion of your building(s) information, utility data and associated metrics (including building-level and sector specific benchmarking) in the analysis done for the annual, published disclosure report on the program results. Your building's data and metrics will contribute to an in-depth assessment of the energy use and greenhouse gas emissions associated with Edmonton's built environment. It is possible that your building's data may also contribute to other energy transition strategy reports and/or the development of related energy transition programs. Building-level data and metrics will remain anonymous within all public reports unless building level disclosure was approved.

Optional Consent: Building Level Disclosure

- If building-level disclosure was approved in section II, you also disclose to sharing of additional information received in response to our data information request about your property(ies) ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager's profile, including (but not limited to) parameters such as whole-building energy use by fuel source, energy performance, whole-building water use, water performance, etc.

Removal of Consent Process

Please note that consent for each building's participation can only be provided on an annual basis, as a result you cannot consent for multiple years at once. The ability to withdraw your consent is dependent on the timing of the withdrawal request. If you wish to withdraw your consent for the public disclosure of your building(s) data please consider:

- If the annual Building Energy Benchmarking Report has not yet been published on the City of Edmonton website then you may request to have your building(s) data removed and your participation revoked by emailing energystar@edmonton.ca
- If the annual Building Energy Benchmarking Report has been published on the City of Edmonton website, you cannot revoke your building(s) consent.

V. SUBMISSIONS & FOIP STATEMENT

This information is being collected by the City under the authority of section 33(c) of the Alberta Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and will be used to authorize public disclosure of building specific energy data, to inform and evaluate Edmonton's Building Energy Benchmarking Program. Aggregate and anonymous data on whole building utility use and associated performance metrics that are collected from building owners and property managers will be used in public energy transition reports, to populate an online disclosure platform and to inform the development of other City of Edmonton energy transition programs focused on energy use in commercial buildings.
