

General Maintenance

- Buy a colour match can of paint and paint over the tags as soon as they appear.
 - **TIP:** Many EcoStations give away donated paint.
- Keep your property clean and free of litter.
- Make sure trees and shrubs are trimmed creating clear sight lines.
- Add on anti-graffiti coating to ease cleaning for high tagging areas.

Lighting

- Keep your property well lit.
- This includes entryways, back alleys, parking lots and corners.

Beautification

- Plain walls attract graffiti.
- Use art, murals, flower pots or simple landscaping.
