Our CPA pre-approved candidates perform their duties across a number of areas, including:

- Corporate Accounting and Reporting;
- Business Financial Analytics;
- Budget Planning and Development; and
- Office of the City Auditor.

Our CPA pre-approved candidates obtain their depth in the competency areas of *Financial Reporting* and *Management Accounting* in addition to meeting the approved core and breadth requirements and enabling competencies.
