Confederation District Park Master Plan

We are working toward a long-term vision for the park site with input from you.

The Master Plan process considers your interests, existing and new amenities and activities, maintenance, City policies and the greater community to renew and update an aging park.

The concept plan shows proposed and existing amenities, buildings, parking and landscaping features. It is intended to show approximate sizes, locations, connections and the design intent, not details. The concept plan protects space for the potential of future developments and guides where potential future developments could go, including how the puzzle pieces will fit together.
