How We Arrived at the Highlands Neighbourhood Renewal Vision and Important Elements

- In February, we invited interested stakeholders to learn more about Neighbourhood Renewal and help spread the word about the project.
- At the same time, we also asked stakeholders for some input on what we should be trying to achieve through Neighbourhood Renewal (i.e., the Vision) and what we need to focus on to achieve it (i.e., the Important Elements).
- We used the stakeholder input as well as survey input collected by the City of Edmonton's Abundant Community representatives in Highlands to **CREATE** a draft Vision and Principles for the project
- In April, we shared a draft vision and set of important elements and, as part of two public engagement sessions, invited people to help us **REFINE** them.
- We received some great input validating parts of our initial drafts and helping us to **REFINE** them.
