## FORT EDMONTON FOOTBRIDGE & TRAILS CONSTRUCTION

NORTH SASKATCHEWAN RIVER FORT EDMONTON FOOTBRIDGE - View from North



Construction of the Fort Edmonton Footbridge and Trails began in August 2008, and the overall project completion is scheduled for fall 2010. The Patricia Ravine Trails and Wolf Willow Ravine Bridge components are complete.

Work remaining to be completed on the Fort Edmonton Footbridge includes the following:

- Bridge Deck Panel grouting and post-tensioning.
- East and West Abutment Concrete Structures  $\approx$  75% complete.
- Bridge Rails and Bridge Lighting.
- River Berm Removal and Site Restoration (Aug – Oct).
- Completion of trails in immediate vicinity of the bridge.

Construction activities are presently occurring primarily during day-time hours from Monday through Saturday, however this may vary during specific construction operations. The City project team and contractor are committed to minimizing the disruption of the surrounding neighborhoods as much as possible.
