EXHIBITION PARK, which name will donate the location of this Park.

KING ALBERT SQUARE (old hospital site) in honour of the present King of Belgium.

WELLINGTON TERRACE (Hillside South of Jasper around the Police (Barracks) after the Duke of Wellington.

MacDonald TERRACE (College Avenue Hillside) after Sir John A. MacDonald.

DOMINION SQUARE Rice Street Market.

VICTORIA PARK named by the Daughters of the Empire.

TIPPERARY SQUARE Park at the corner of Peace & 14th.

MOUNT ROYAL PARK Northerly Park donated by the Hudson's Bay Co. at the request of the Company (H. B. R.)

HARDISTY PARK Easterly Park donated by the H. B. Co., at the request of the Company (H. B. R.)

V QUEEN MARY PARK Park to the South in the H. B. R. after our present Queen.

QUEEN ELIZABETH PARK Westerly park in the H. B. R. after the Queen of the Belgians.

GROAT RAVINE PARK after the late Malcolm Groat who gave the land to the City.

WESTMOUNT CHARTERY PARK West End Park.
