

SNOW CLEARING SERVICE LEVELS

Edmonton

When it snows our crews are out. When snowfall stops, our priority clearing system begins.

ROADWAYS

ESSENTIAL ROADS

Main freeways, bus routes, downtown business district and hills.



**COMPLETED
WITHIN 1 DAY**

ARTERIAL AND COLLECTOR ROADS

Remaining freeways, arterial roadways, business districts, collector roadways, Transit Park and Ride access roads.



**COMPLETED
WITHIN 5 DAYS**

INDUSTRIAL ROADS

Industrial hubs and rural roadways.



**COMPLETED
WITHIN 6 DAYS**

LOCAL/RESIDENTIAL ROADS

Residential roadways and neighbourhood alleys are completed as part of a Phase 2 Parking Ban.

WITHIN 14 DAYS**

ACTIVE PATHWAYS

CORE FACILITIES AND PATHWAYS

City facilities and prioritized active pathway network (Winter Bike Loop)



**COMPLETED
WITHIN 1 DAY**

MACHINE CITY-MAINTAINED PATHWAYS AND TRANSIT ACCESS

Remaining City-maintained sidewalks, shared-use pathways, parking lots and bridge decks.



**COMPLETED
WITHIN 3 DAYS**

MANUAL CITY- MAINTAINED PATHWAYS AND TRANSIT ACCESS

Manually cleared paths, bus stop benches and pads.



**COMPLETED
WITHIN 14 DAYS**

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

Community sandboxes, safe mobility devices.

PARKING BANS

Snow clearing is a shared responsibility. Have a plan before we call a parking ban.

MAJOR ROADWAYS (PHASE 1)

Major roads including core business areas and bus routes.



**LASTS UP
TO 5 DAYS**

RESIDENTIAL (PHASE 2)

Residential and industrial areas.



**LASTS UP TO 14 DAYS
- ONCE A BAN
IS ACTIVATED**

Vehicles in place once the ban is in effect are subject to ticketing.

DID YOU KNOW?

The City clears over 500 km of active pathways and over 12,000 km of roads. That's almost as far as going to England and back.



SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

Property owners must clear snow from the front and sides of their property promptly after snowfall to improve safety and accessibility.

SIDEWALKS

Property owners can add salt and sand to icy sidewalks. Failure to maintain sidewalks could result in a \$100 fine. Sand is available at 100 community sandbox locations.

LIVE MAP

Watch the plows in action on the live map. When a snow event occurs, the map also displays the clearing status of every roadway.

CENTRE WINDROWS

A long line of snow heaped up along the centre of the road will be picked up within 5 days of their priority level being completed.

ALLEYS are completed as part of the same priority as their adjacent roadway.
