### REVIEW INFRASTRUCTURE CAPACITY TO SUPPORT INFILLS

Priority nodes have been integrated into the City Plan during Action 1 will undergo an analysis of infrastructure systems. The City is working with EPCOR and other stakeholders to catalogue utility information within these priority areas. Work has begun to retain a consultant to complete a detailed infrastructure analysis of each node.

# RE-EXAMINE COLLECTIVE HOUSING REGULATIONS

On July 15, 2019 amendments to the Zoning Bylaw were passed to increase the supply of affordable and permanent supportive housing. These amendments apply a human rights based approach to land-use planning and improve the safety of groups homes.
