Put your unwanted table scraps into the pail or cart.

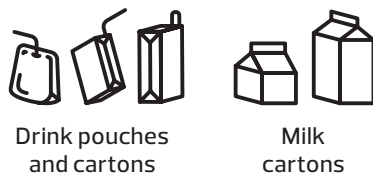
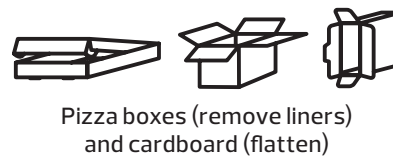
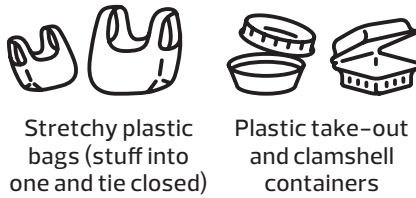
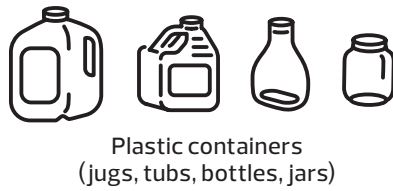

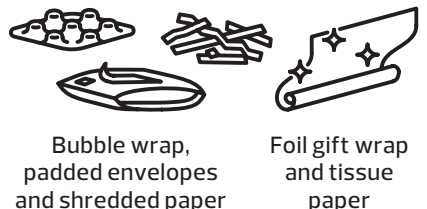
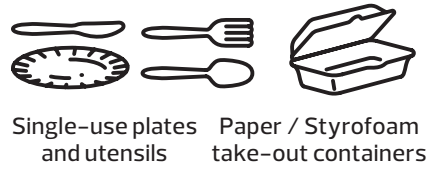
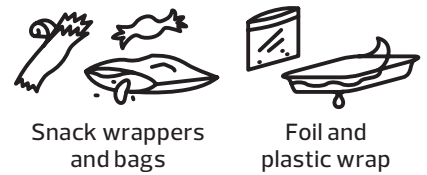
RECYCLING

Keep items **loose**.
Rinse and **dry** containers.
Remove caps and lids, put in the garbage.
Bundle large pieces of cardboard.
Place underneath your blue bag.



GARBAGE

Bags are optional.
Put in the **garbage cart**.
Cart **lid** must **close**.

YARD WASTE

Set out for **seasonal collection**, put in a **paper** or **see-through plastic** bag.

Leaves and grass (or go bagless)

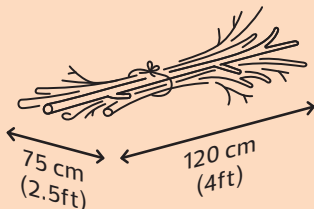


Fallen tree fruit Garden trimmings, dead plants and cones

Home composting is still the best thing to do with yard waste and food scraps.

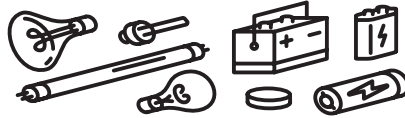
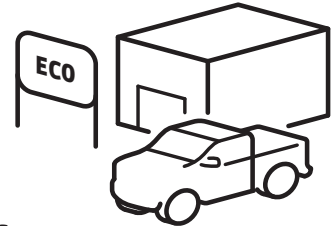

Chemicals and cleaners



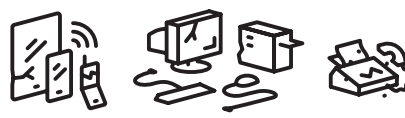
Motor oil, oil filters

Propane tanks



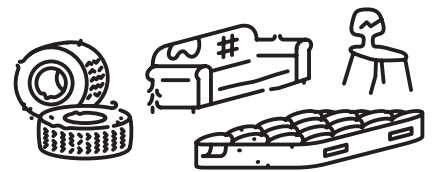
Appliances and power tools

Lawnmowers (fluids drained)

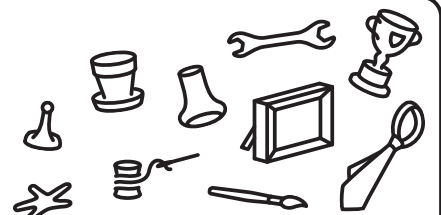
Scrap metal
